Algorithms: we're all plugged in

Whether we know/believe/admit it or not, they're controlling our minds (both overtly and covertly). Who's writing the rules that determine what we see on our news feeds? Money talks. We've mindlessly opted into social media not realizing that it's a giant social experiment run by elitists with extremist ideologies. Big tech megacorps have been knowingly and unknowingly colluding with eachother and with the U.S. and foreign governments to push nefarious agendas. Collectively, they know more about us than we know about ourselves — whether we've given them permission to or not, they've been storing and using unreasonable amounts of data about us: every place we've been, gps coordinates including long/lat/altitude, timestamps, speed, direction, etc., every webpage or ad we've seen, what device/browser we used, movie, tv show, news, song or podcast we've listened to, every search we've made, purchase we've made, who we are related to, work with, friends with, what we like, what we say, what we believe — and they use that information to decide what we should see and hear and they use psychological profiles to attempt to manipulate our subconscious and change what we like, what we purchase, what we say, and what we believe.
